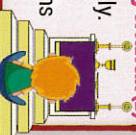

9 Be joyful as you watch and wait for this month to unfold



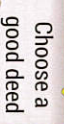
10 **2nd Sunday of Advent (B)**

16 Make Christmas cards



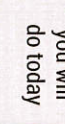
17 **3rd Sunday of Advent (B)**

18 What was John the Baptist's message? (John 1:23)



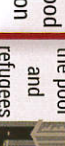

1 Make a wish and a promise that you will try and achieve this year



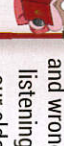

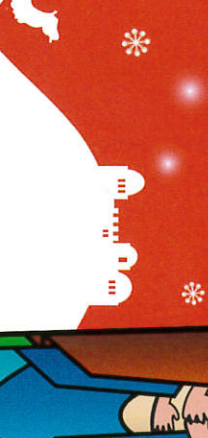
6 **The Epiphany of the Lord: (Ireland)**
